DETAILS OF THE OPPORTUNITY

This position is funded by the CTSA Grant

- Works alongside the current CRC Director at initially 10% effort to become proficient at running the CRC and will eventually lead to becoming the Director at 40% effort
- Leads, manages and provides general oversight, including quality assurance and training of the ITS Clinical Research Center
- Directs all Phase I/II activities of the Clinical Research Center, including management of human and durable resources, assuring the responsible conduct of research and subject safety, research compliance, education and training
- Reviews investigator efforts to assure safety, especially in First-in-Human studies. He assures the education and training on the unique aspects of Phase I/II research for students at all levels
- Reviews, approves and assures that research protocols are carried out as approved and that protocols provide a focus for teaching of clinical research
- Directs all activities of the Clinical Research Center Core Laboratory
- Ensures all individuals within the Participant and Clinical Interactions module adhere to evaluation and continuous improvement data collection expectations
- Serves on the following committees: CTSA Operations Committee, Human Subjects Data Security, CRC Education Task Force, Scientific Review Committee
- Works closely with other ITS components as well as NCATS Domain Task Forces and Working Groups to carry out both local ITS and National NCATS translational research missions
- Serves as a liaison with investigators, nursing staff, research ethics experts, IRB and compliance officers to assure research is carried out under Good Clinical/Laboratory Practice standards and that it adheres to the tenets of research compliance standards for the responsible conduct of research and to the tenets of research compliance
