

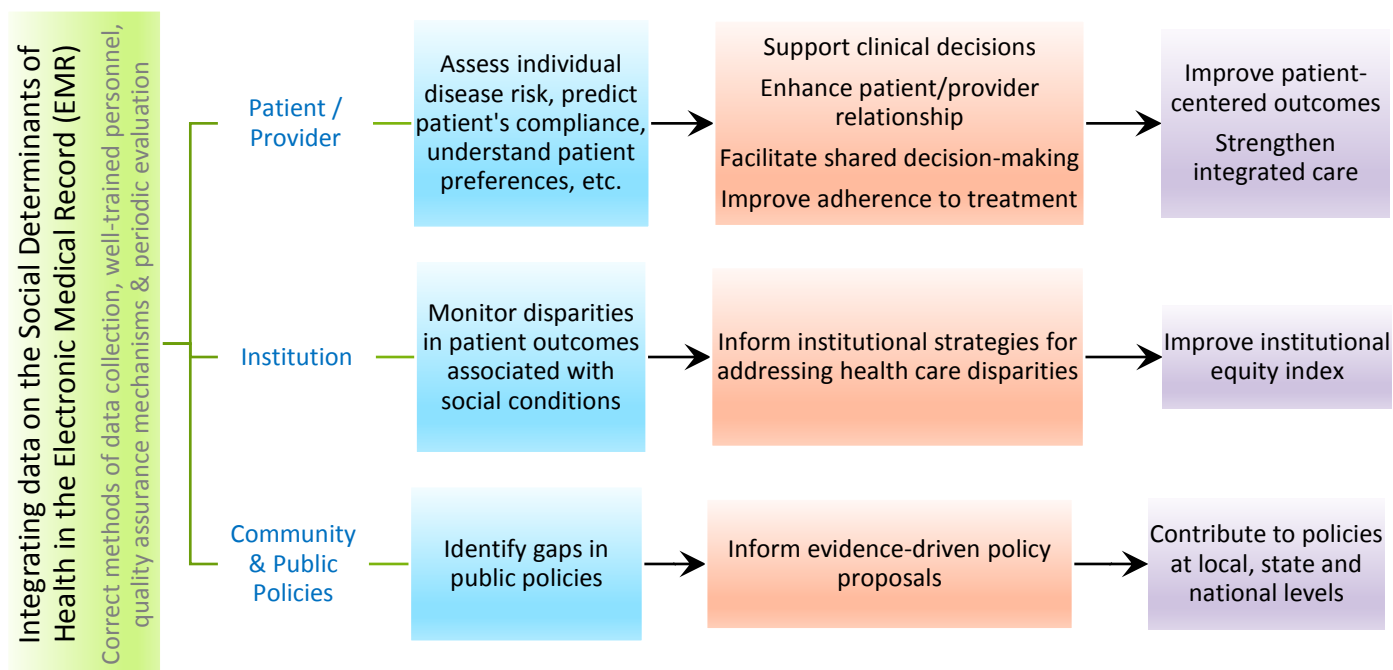
Using the Electronic Medical Record (EMR) in Monitoring and Addressing Health Disparities
